# EMERGING NARRATIVES

2022 was a year of Emerging Narratives marked by a combination of honoring our deep history as a leader in the Enneagram space and intentional planning for the future we want to create together.

We began the year with the board re-examining our governance model and ended with a three-day strategic planning retreat in Boulder, CO to create a plan to guide our work for 2023-2025 and beyond. We also launched a new website and technology platform, returned to some in-person programming for the first time since early March 2020, and received the honor of being named the first International Enneagram Association Accredited School with Distinction.

Erlina spent most of 2022 in the Board President's role before entering into the role of Executive Director in December to guide The Narrative Enneagram's strategy, fund development, partnerships, and DEIB efforts. We are grateful for Outgoing Executive Director Ed Self's significant contributions during his tenure. His work played an integral role in bringing us into a new world of critical thinking and technological advances while strengthening our internal processes with organizational rigor.

Erlina is joined in leadership by Co-Executive Director Allison DeHart, who brings a strong background in accounting, finance, and operations. Margot Burns stepped into the role of Board President to guide us in our work to transform lives and create a more compassionate world.

We also welcomed three new board members steeped in education and business expertise - Julie Smith, Karen Fields, and Kenneth Alexander - and thank them for their time and commitment and the contributions they delivered thus far. 2022 also saw the addition of Julia Gatten as our new Marketing and Communications Director and the promotion of Satoya Foster to our newly created position of Program Director.

### THE NARRATIVE ENNEAGRAM

#### **EMERGING NARRATIVES CONTINUED**

During this year of emergence, we found ourselves asking, "Is the Enneagram for everyone?" As much as we'd like to say yes, we recognize our history of centering dominant narratives. In 2022, we conducted Listening Circles where we invited Black, Indigenous, and other People of Color (BIPOC) to share their experiences with our courses, faculty, staff, and materials. This solidified our commitment to Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) to create a world where the Enneagram is more accessible to everyone.

Working towards a more inclusive and accessible Enneagram will take all of us, and we're grateful for the significant interest from our donors to partner in this work. In 2022, you provided funding for more scholarships than ever before (over \$58,000), including a dedicated BIPOC Scholarship fund along with funding for those holding other marginalized identities like people who are LGBTQ+, disabled, and neurodivergent. Your funding also provided a path to continue adding more Associate and Adjunct Faculty to meet the needs of diverse communities.

We are grateful for the clarity of progress we made in 2022, which has served us well thus far this year. We look forward to presenting our next chapter in the coming year. Thank you for being an important part of our work together.



Board, faculty, staff, and advisors at the November 2022 Strategic Planning session






