

Executive Director's Report

To our Narrative Enneagram Community,

Let's take a moment to notice our breath and follow it "in and down" as our co-founder Helen Palmer would often encourage her students. As you do so, connect with the impact the Enneagram has had in your life. We may have similar memories of an ah-ha moment that arose while listening to a panelist share their experience of type, a moment that led to deeper understanding and compassion for self and others.

Our world needs this wisdom more than ever – the wisdom to cultivate grounded presence, to connect with all three centers of intelligence, and to engage the complexities before us with compassionate curiosity.

It takes strategic vision and collaborative creativity to foster the possibility for these insightful and life-changing moments to occur, for this wisdom to arise. With that aim, in 2024, we continued working towards our goals of improving our educational programs, offering more community gatherings, building financial stability, cultivating a high functioning team, and making the Enneagram more accessible to everyone.

Core Faculty member, Christopher T. Copeland, in his new role as Dean of Faculty, led a curriculum review and update. This was a major undertaking, at times stretching the capacity of our small staff. We are proud of the changes we've implemented to make our curriculum more accessible and meaningful to a diverse student population.



On June 29, 2024, we held our first <u>Professional Certification Program</u> online graduation to celebrate the first twenty-seven graduates under the new cohort model, which we launched in 2023. The Narrative Enneagram faculty, staff, and board joined with graduates and their families to mark this major accomplishment where each student shared a few words about their experience. The ceremony was a heartwarming celebration for all who participated and a confirmation that the new cohort model is working to create additional support and a deeper sense of worth and belonging for our students.

In 2024, we began offering quarterly <u>Everyday Exploration</u> workshops. These time and budget-friendly courses provide opportunities to dive deeper into a variety of Enneagram topics. In 2024, the topics included Origins of the Enneagram Types, The Enneagram and Spirituality, Preventing Burnout with the Enneagram, and Conscious Parenting. Our intention with these offerings is to create a bridge between the Essential Enneagram Test and Experiencing the Narrative Enneagram, the first of our four Foundational Courses.

We remain committed to increasing the diversity of Enneagram leaders in the fields of teaching, coaching, consulting, spiritual direction, and beyond. In 2024, we dedicated half of our scholarship funds to BIPOC students, and outgoing Co-Executive Director Erlina Edwards led an ongoing affinity group to support Black students pursuing certification. We are grateful for Erlina's continued DEIB leadership in 2025 as we work towards individual, collective, and structural transformation.

I invite you to return to your breath and the memory that came to you as you began to read this letter. Remember the gift of that moment – the insight, understanding, compassion, and new possibilities that opened within you. With your support we will continue to share that gift with more people everyday.

Dean of Faculty's Report


As a valued supporter of The Narrative Enneagram, we are excited to share this important milestone with you.

In 2023, we launched an in-depth review and revision of our foundational curriculum with two primary goals:


- To reflect our deep commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging (DEIB) throughout our curriculum content and teaching practices.














We taught elements of the updated curriculum in our Foundational Courses throughout 2024 as we refined the material and then shared it with our community of certified professionals in January 2025. The Professional Certification Program also reflects the updated curriculum.



Community Spotlight Theresa Branaugh


Learning about the Enneagram and exploring our type invites us to meet our true essence and to reconcile with the armor we have created to shield us from pain and life's many challenges.

Identifying that I lead with Type 6 and understanding of those patterns has been an important tool in my journey towards healing from the deep wounds of a violent and troubled childhood.

It was not easy at first for me to participate in panels. I felt very vulnerable. I was being invited to go to places that would eventually give me freedom and strength, but I wasn't getting there without being brave and curious.


By watching panels, I have also gained greater awareness of what some of my family members are up against. I can better understand the struggles my mom faces as an 89-year old woman who never had the benefit of this kind of work.

The Enneagram has led me to places that have been uncomfortable and challenging—as well as to places of clarity, humility, and gratitude. No one can do this work for me, and I am grateful to be part of this community.



Celebrating a 20-year Enneagram collaboration

On November 3, 2024, we held a celebratory event marking the much-anticipated book launch of <u>PERSONALITY AND WHOLENESS IN THERAPY: INTEGRATING 9</u> PATTERNS OF DEVELOPMENTAL PATHWAYS IN CLINICAL PRACTICE.



This groundbreaking book resulted from a 20-year collaboration between TNE co-founder Dr. David Daniels and leading experts Dan Siegel, Denise Daniels (David's daughter), Jack Killen, and Laura Baker. Renowned author and gifted storyteller Dan Siegel shared a short teaching on key themes from the book and Terry Saracino facilitated a panel of the authors followed by a Q&A session.

We had over 700 people register for this event including long-time members of our community and many who were joining us for the first time!

Essential Guide Series

The 34-page <u>Essential Guide to the Nine Types</u> offers an introduction to the Enneagram along with a 3-page profile of each type including motivation, strengths, challenges, and more. We also created a detailed <u>16-page guide</u> for each of the 9 types. These are great resources to grow your personal understanding of the nine types or to enhance your professional knowledge if you work with individual clients or groups.

Support Growth and Increase Awareness

The strategies in "Supporting Growth in Yourself and Others" will assist you in working with reactivity and building the capacity for more flexibility and freedom in your life and relationships. "Awareness Practices and Reflections" includes 5 guided awareness questions and 5 reflections for each of the nine Enneagram types. These are perfect to support your own mindfulness practice, serve as journaling prompts you can return to over time, or enhance your work with individual clients or groups.

Video Series with Terry Saracino

In each recording, Founding President and Core Faculty member Terry Saracino guides you through an inner practice followed by a practical teaching focused on ways you can engage the Enneagram in your daily life and deepen your understanding of yourself, others, and the world. Themes include: Cultivating Compassion, Everyday Awe, Vital Relationships, Inviting Stillness, and Somatic Integration.






